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
25 YEARS OF SRUJANAVANI


RATION KIT DISTRIBUTION TO THE VULNERABLE

The ill effects of COVID continue unabated. People, particularly those belonging to the vulnerable sections of the society are the most affected by CoVID-19 pandemic. Artisans, artists, private school teachers, and migrant laborers formed part of the ration-kit distribution. In our survey we found some heart wrenching stories of the lives of the stage artists, harikatha performers. Supporting these sections of the society with groceries sufficient worth a month has been satisfying. Around 1200+kits were distributed with the support of Sarojini Damodaran Foundation.




MIDHANI LEARNING CENTRE
